CONNECTED TEACHER PROJECT

The Connected Teacher Project is designed to support early career primary and early years teachers to develop as skilful, creative, reflective practitioners, bringing them together into an interactive online cohort of peers.

The six-session online CPD is designed to be affordable and manageable during our current times, enabling teachers to take part in the morning and teach in the afternoons.

We focus on developing reflection, learning to listen, building relationships and meeting pupils' needs, as well as two sessions focused on creative practice in the arts and English. We meld research and practice.

This draws together the expertise of facilitators, Jonny Walker and Jo Castro, both of whom are experienced teachers, school leaders, arts facilitators and initial teacher training lecturers.
